



Take Home Aftercare Instructions for Microblading

You may experience the following during the healing process:

Dryness and itching in the treated area

Flaking

Tenderness

YOU MUST FOLLOW THIS REGIMEN OF DAILY CARE:

- Do not let any water, lotion, soap, or makeup touch your eyebrow area during the first 7 days after your procedure. Please wash your face around your eyebrow without getting water on your treated area.
- Do not touch the treated area unless applying ointment. No scratching, rubbing or picking of the treated area.
- For at least 7-10 days after the procedure, do not rub the procedure area when washing your face.
- Apply a rice grain amount of ointment 3 times a day on treated area for the recommended time frame. (usually 3-5 days)
- For the first 30 days following the procedure, avoid swimming and sun exposure. Do not submerge brows in chlorine or salt water for 30 days.
- Always use sunscreen on the eyebrows and/or lips from this point on.
- No heavy exercise for the next 10 days to avoid sweating. Also avoid long showers.
- Do not use heavy face creams, exfoliators, or harsh cleansers on brows during healing process.
- Do not use growth enhancement products such as Latisse, RevitaBrow, and GrandeLash 1 month before or after the procedure has fully healed due to possibility of the color shifting.
- Any fading or loss of pigment that may occur during healing may re-appear a few days or weeks later. Any pigment loss will be recovered at the follow up appointment between 4-8 weeks.
- No Facials, Botox, Microdermabrasion, Dermaplaning, or chemical treatments for 4 weeks after procedure.
- No Retin-A, Alpha Hydroxy or Glycolic acids ever ON Microbladed brows.
- Client may be allowed to donate blood within the standard deferral period if the client presents a copy of his/her client record provided by the body art facility to the blood donor facility.

And most important of all: if the pigmented area becomes infected or painful, or if you should develop a fever soon after the pigmentation procedure, please seek medical attention IMMEDIATELY and also contact Design 1!
